

## The Engineering & Technology Explorers Post

The Engineering & Technology Explorers Post program is part of outreach efforts by the American Council of Engineering Companies, Minnesota Chapter (ACEC/MN). It gives students and volunteers a chance to set aside the books and lectures and get hands-on experience with projects that have real-world inspiration and application.



The Explorers Post program is a career education program for youths between the ages of 14 and 20, and is one of seven programs under the Learning for Life umbrella (a wholly owned subsidiary of Boy Scouts of America).
