Waconia Ice Arena

Gausman & Moore, teaming with RSP Architects, designed the mechanical and electrical systems for this new indoor 40,000 square foot ice arena. The project includes an NHL sized rink with 650 seats and standing room on the mezzanine for 250 more. There is a raised, enclosed, heated viewing area that holds another 100 fans. Also included are two concession stands, a pro shop, and two meeting rooms. There are four youth hockey sized locker rooms and two varsity sized locker rooms. Linear fluorescent lighting offers three levels of lighting in the ice arena. Construction was completed Spring 2008.

This addition adds a third sheet of ice to the facility and an NHL sized rink with seating for 300. Also included are locker rooms, an upper seating/viewing area, conference rooms, meeting rooms, and a new team entrance/lobby. The project included replacement of the refrigeration plant and the addition of A/C to the corridors. Fire protection was incorporated into the existing building as well as an upgraded gas-fired desiccant dehumidification system and upsized electrical service. Estimated completion is October 2008.
